In order to cope with the strong growth of their population, twelve municipalities at the foot of the Jura joined forces to extend the secondary school in Apples.

The L-shaped building marks the entrance to the village betweeen the agricultural zone and the orchards. It houses the classrooms and special-purpose areas, a multipurpose sports hall and the municipal council hall. The large volume under a single roof and the copper cladding are reminiscent of farmhouses in the Vaud region. Inside, the large windows provide both a sense of intimacy and a panoramic view of Lake Geneva.
