



## EAUX-VIVES RAILWAY STATION DISTRICT IN GENEVA

The Eaux-Vives railway station district is near the city center with excellent public transport connections and local public services. It represents a significant center for urban development. The aim is to develop cultural and sports activities and facilities, in addition to a major public transport hub around the main left bank railway station of the Cornavin-Eaux-Vives-Annemasse (CEVA) line.

Two large complexes will be built facing each other on opposite sides of a linear public space. The project is multifaceted with a wide range of functions: 240 residential units, sports and leisure facilities, commercial areas and an underground car park.
