The Olympic Museum was inaugurated in 1993 in a magnificent estate overlooking the Lake Geneva landscapes.

Thirty years later, the museum was reorganized in keeping with the architecture in place: the permanent exhibition areas were extended from 2,000 to 3,000 m2, the interior pathway and museography reorganized, the reception and restaurant areas of the panoramic roof terrace enlarged and protected by a fine net of fibre-reinforced concrete slats. The construction was carried out as part of a total professional services contract with a cost guarantee.
