HISTORY MUSEUM IN LAUSANNE

Overlooking the modern city on the southern slopes of the historic quarter, the building of the Ancien-Evêché has undergone, through the centuries, many campaigns of reconstruction and conversion works. Since 100 years the museum houses and displays the physical and non-physical heritage of the city of Lausanne. The exposing of more recent parts of the structure, without impacting its protected historical construction, has allowed the reorganization of the space creating a thematic itinerary adapted to the particularities of each room. The intervention sought to unite the space, the works and their presentation.
