After the authorization of a masterplan aiming to develop a technology park on its large 43,000 m2 site in Meyrin, Hewlett-Packard carried out a three-stage operation: a sale-and-leaseback financial transaction involving the sale of its assets as consideration for a long-term lease of new headquarters for the 450 employees of its two companies; the construction of a large temporary modular datacenter; and finally, the construction of a new datacenter showroom for its clients in its former headquarters. In addition to a restaurant and a car park, the new headquarters also houses open-space offices combined with numerous meeting and informal discussion spaces.
