HES-SO GRADUATE SCHOOL IN FRIBOURG

Under a single roof the building unites the social work institute HEF-TS, the healthcare institute HedS-FR and the upper management of HES-SO. The project is part of the redevelopment of the Arsenaux site.

The building's core circulation space is varied over five levels to suit the different uses of the premises: refectory, auditoriums, classrooms and offices. Modular spaces accommodate various forms of team work and plenary sessions. The Skills Labs enable the acquisition of clinical skills through simulation (mannequins, test patients).
