SECONDARY SCHOOL IN BUSSIGNY

The Dalaz district is built on the edge of a large valley floor. Due to its size, consisting approximately of a hundred houses, its architectural coherence and its shared amenities – it represents a significant collective residential complex from the 1970's. The school is built at the center of the complex.

The school is extended by a single-story U shaped building wrapped around a courtyard that opens out onto the neighborhood on one side. The double sports hall is located on the hillside overlooking the Jura landscape and the future neighbourhood of West Bussigny. A wood-fired heating plant serving a district heating network heats all the school buildings in the municipality. The college received the prize of West Lausanne in 2018.
